Adthrive, now rebranded as Raptive, is a full-service creator media company that empowers creators and publishers to make revenue with their website.

Although the platform offers higher payments than most ad networks, its list of limitations remains. Here's what most publishers have faced:

- Eligibility that's tough to meet: Your website needs a consistent stream of 100,000 page views every month, Google Analytics needs to be set up properly, content should be 100% original, and the majority of the traffic should come from the US, the UK, Australia, and New Zealand.
- Limited control: Publishers have limited control over the kind of ads that will be displayed on their website.
- Lack of communication: Many publishers have faced a lack of communication and support from AdThrive's team.
- High processing fee: Some users have also reported a high processing fee when

receiving payouts.

All this puts the platform in a gray area, so you may want to consider other AdThrive alternatives instead.
